Larry Miller, Woodturner

In his own words:

I make what I like to call “Functional Art”, which are items turned on a lathe from reclaimed/recycled wood that have a functional use yet reflects the natural beauty of the wood. I’ve been teaching woodturning for the past 15 years in my shop to students of all ages; I was founder and president of the Olympia woodturning club; have been a volunteer at the Olympia high school wood shop since 2012 and chair the youth program for the American Association of Woodturners (AAW). I’m often called to make specialty items and do restorations work to order.

The demonstration for the Strait Turners was titled, “leave a natural edge on it”.

Larry brought several different turned objects that have a natural edge, describe the process for completing the project, and then demonstrated the making of a natural edge bowl, showing the techniques he uses.

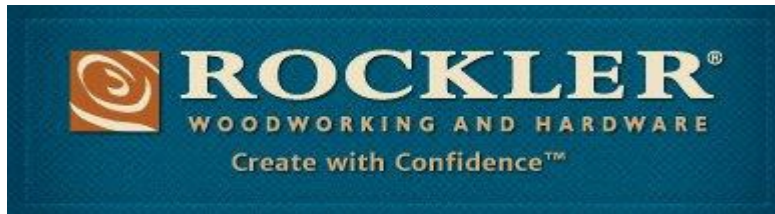
